Intent:

As part of our catch up programme we ran the government backed summer programme for our year 6 into 7 intake. This programme was designed to build confidence in young children that have seen a significant impact on their educational journey in comparison to previous years.

Implementation:

The summer school provision was run via the government backed organisation <u>Teach Us Camp</u>. Due to the importance of this programme, those teaching students were members of our teaching staff. Session offered over the 5 days included:

- Maths
- English
- Dance
- Drama
- Physical fitness and education

In accordance with the conditions of funding our summer school provided:

- Structured programme of study;
- Stationary, workbooks, drawstring bag(s), scientific calculator and reusable water bottles;
- Marketing of camp to ensure a high level of uptake (What was the number? % of the eventual cohort);
- PC tablets to those students with 100% attendance and behaviour;
- Team building and social well-being trip to amusement park;
- Catering for all students and staff attending the programme;
- First aid staff on site;
- Administrative staff;
- Final celebrations for parents to recognise the hard work of their children.

(The external providers fees per students were £298.50 per week)

Impact:

- High attendance to school
- High punctuality to school
- Positive behaviour points
- Engagement in extra-curricular / intervention and enrichment opportunities
