Re: Monday 10 October 2022 - Mufti day for #HelloYellow

For the second year, Shirley High School is putting Mental Health and well-being at the centre of its community by supporting 'World Mental Health Day' on Monday 10 October 2022. We have a vision that 'students and staff are informed and empowered to be emotionally literate and resilient individuals through a fully embedded mental health and wellbeing programme'.

Students will be allowed to wear mufti on this day as long as they wear one yellow item of clothing (jumper, tshirt or trousers). This national initiative stands out as a demonstration of our community's support for those struggling with poor mental health. We trust our students when taking part in events like this, to maintain the high expectations of dress and ensure that what they wear is appropriate and clearly linked to the ethos of the day.

Please ensure that your child understands that although he / she has been awarded a Mufti Day, our Golden Rule and the high standards expected in relation to attendance / punctuality, behaviour and commitment remain. The following are not permitted:

- Clothing that exposes the bare midriff, cleavage, chest, bottom or upper thighs
- Offensive logos or slogans
- Headwear (unless for religious reasons)

It is also expected that all equipment needed for the day e.g. PE or PA kit, should be brought as usual especially their student planners and writing materials.
