## Personal Development Department - Year 10



Our curriculum takes a thematic approach, which covers six spiral core themes that progressively run through each year group: Health and Wellbeing Life Beyond School Rights, Responsibilities and British Values Careers Education Staying Safe Online and Offline RSE The themes are built upon each year and lessons within these themes cover the statutory requirements for RSE and Health and Wellbeing, Citizenship and British Values. Personal Development lessons also meet the requirements of the Gatsby benchmarks.

The year 10 curriculum has a strong focus on mental health and wellbeing, designed to coincide with students beginning their GCSE courses. Students build on their knowledge of British Values, beginning to link together prior learning on sexuality, British Values and human rights. Learning around personal safety extends to knife crime, modern slavery and honor based killing and students prepare for their one week work experience placemen in July.
