Take part in our World Book Week competition and design a poster to celebrate the National Year of Reading.

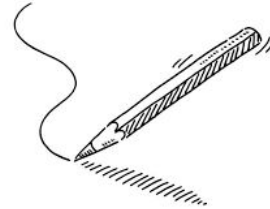

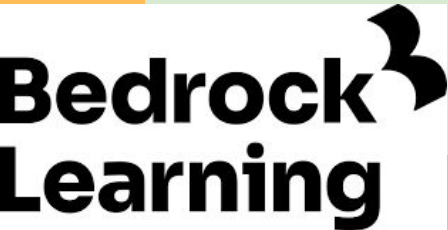

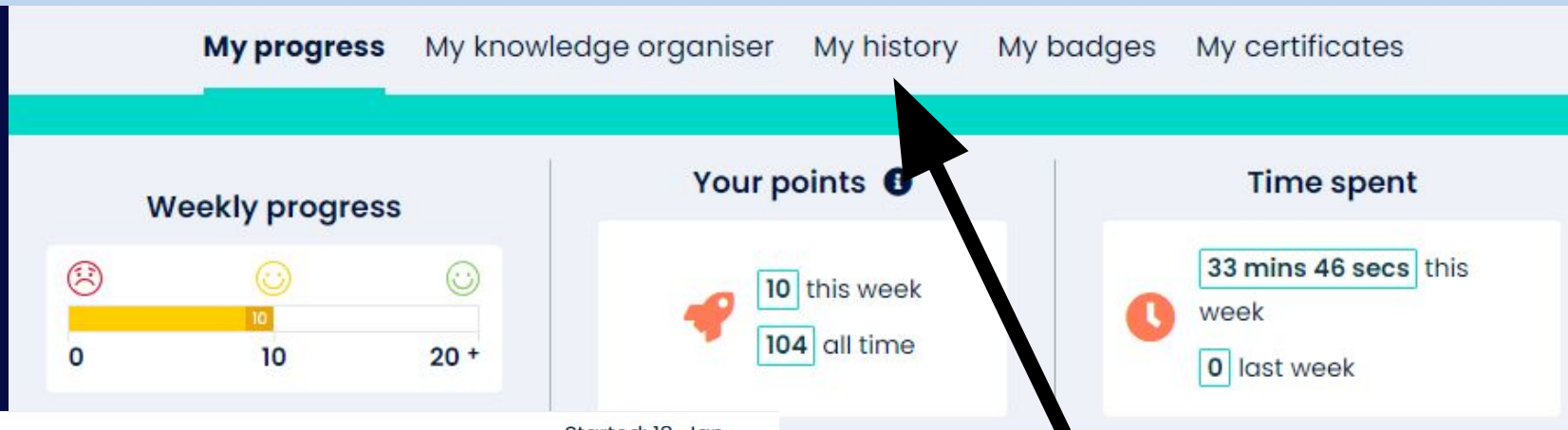
