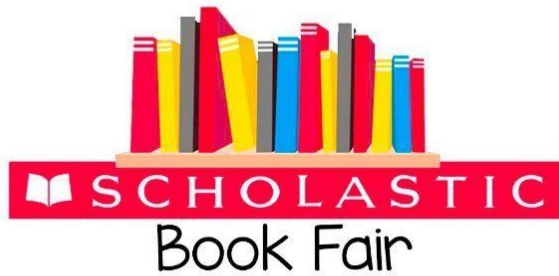


2026 is the National Year of Reading!

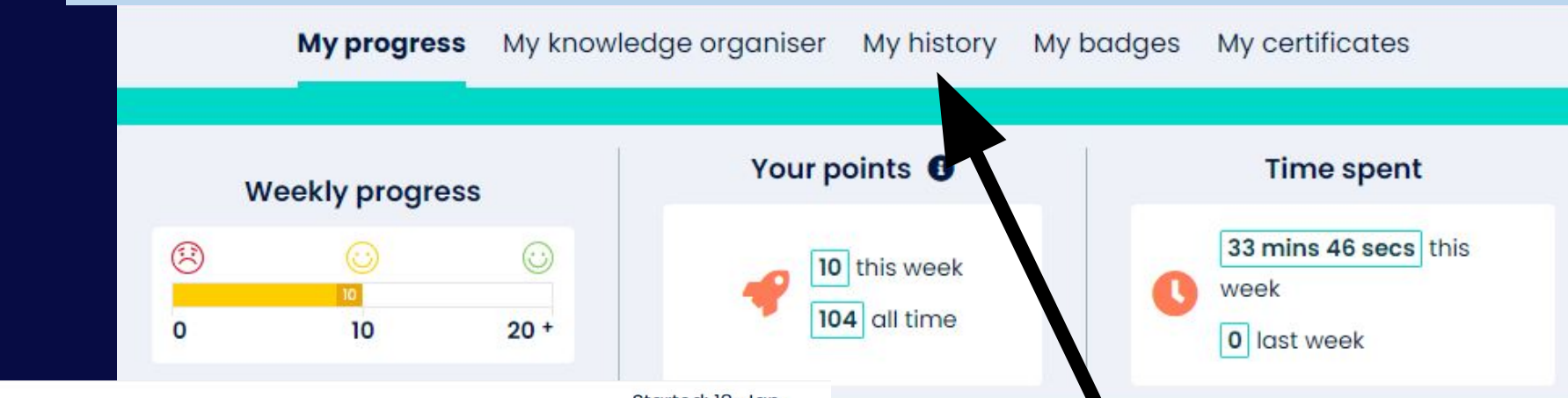
