Toilets - Urgent Message

- No eating in the toilets;
- No vandalism to the toilets.

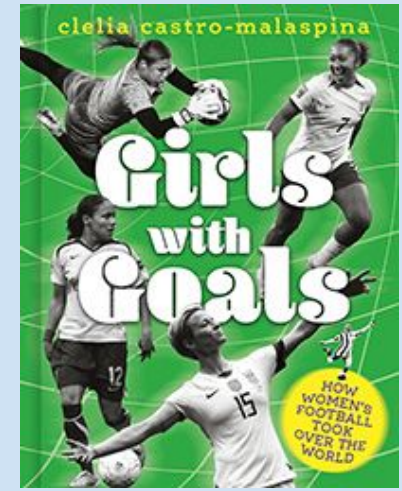
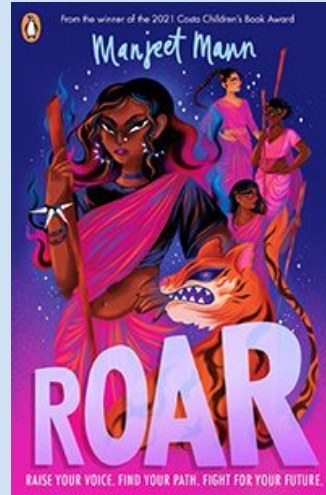

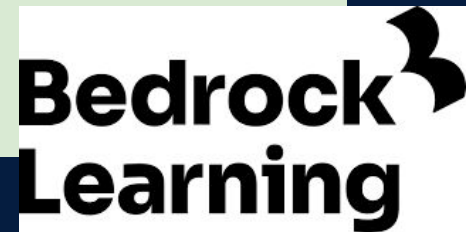
