Important Reminders

Early Warning Bell

An early warning bell will go at:

- The start of school

A second bell will then signify the start of the end period. Pupils have approximately 3 minutes to be lining up at their class. Those that arrive to lesson after the start of lesson bell will be given a detention for lateness.

School Opening
