RE: Year 12 Conferences / Literature Trips

I have organised three events to support your child in their English Literature A level. The three trips will cover aspects of the A level course: 'Taming of the Shrew' and 'The Great Gatsby'. These trips will support their studies.

These events have been heavily subsidised but there is a cost of £26.00.

Event one: A Workshop at The Globe Theatre – Tuesday 3 March 2020

This event is ensuring students understand context and develops on Shakespeare. Students will leave school at 10.50 am. Students can either make their own way to the theatre or leave with Mrs Harris (Head of Sixth Form). The event finishes at 3.30 pm and students will be dismissed from the theatre or can return to school with Mrs Harris.

Event two: Conference on 'The Great Gatsby' – Monday 16 March 2020

This event is a day of lectures on this A Level text. Students are to meet at East Croydon station at 9.30 am. Students should have enough money on their Oyster card to travel to London. The conference is being held at Bloomsbury Central Baptist Church – Shaftsbury Avenue. The event finishes at 3.30 pm. Students can be dismissed at the venue or travel back to East Croydon with their teacher: Ms Fair (Vice Principal).

Event three: A performance of 'Taming of The Shrew - Wednesday 1 April 2020

This is a matinee performance where students will leave school at 12.10 pm. Students can either make their own way to the theatre or leave with Mrs Rehman (English Teacher). The event finishes at 5.15 pm and students will be dismissed from the theatre or can return to East Croydon with Mrs Rehman.

Students should be dressed in smart / casual attire and should either bring money for lunch or a packed lunch - they will be given time to get food in groups.

All three trips will cost £26.00 and payments must be made via ParentPay.
